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TECHNICAL INFORMATION



REGISTRATION

Quantitative registration:

- until May 20, 2026

Nominal registration:

- until June 20, 2026



PARTICIPATION

- Official university competition
- Up to 16 teams in total
- Roster of 18 to 20 players per team



SPORTS PROTOCOL

- Arrival at the stadium: 60 minutes before the match
- Roster submission and verification: 45 minutes before the match
- Warm-up begins: 30 minutes before the match



ESSENTIAL REQUIREMENTS

- Mandatory use of official accreditation
- Valid medical and accident insurance
- Two uniform sets: one light-colored and one dark-colored

OFFICIAL COMPETITION BALL

The IV FISU America Football - Lima 2026 will use the official Molten Vantaggio 5000 ball, certified to the FIFA Quality Pro standard and designed for high-level international competitions.

JULY WEATHER

During the tournament, Lima experiences a mild winter climate, with temperatures around:

Minimum	Maximum
15° C	21° C

The weather is usually cool and humid, with predominantly cloudy skies and little rainfall. Delegations are advised to bring light warm clothing.



CURRENCY AND PAYMENT METHODS

The official currency of Peru is the Peruvian Sol (S/).

S/ 3.43 per USD 1*.

The exchange rate may vary daily.



TRANSPORTATION

To travel safely and efficiently around the city, it is recommended to use reliable transportation services such as Uber, Cabify, and Satelital.

VOLTAGE AND POWER PLUGS

In Peru, the standard voltage is 220V and the frequency is 60Hz.

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SPORTS VENUES

NATIONAL UNIVERSITY OF SAN MARCOS STADIUM.

One of the most iconic sports venues in the country and host of major international competitions, including the Lima 2019 Pan American Games and the South American U-17 Championship.

- Capacity: 32,000 spectators.
- Address: University Campus – UNMSM, Francisco Moreyra y Riglos 637.



IVÁN ELÍAS MORENO STADIUM.

One of the main sports venues in southern Lima, used for national competitions and major professional tournaments with large attendance.

- Capacity: 13,773 spectators.
- Address: Los Álamos Avenue, Villa El Salvador, Lima, Peru.



VIDU

Sports complex located in southern Lima, used for training sessions and sports development events.

- Capacity: 5,000 spectators.
- Address: Km. 29.5 of the Pan-American Highway South – Lurín.



NATIONAL STADIUM

Peru's main sports venue and host of major international competitions, official events, and national team matches.

- Capacity: 43,000 spectators.
- Address: José Díaz Street, s/n, Lima District.



MONUMENTAL STADIUM

One of the largest stadiums in South America, hosting national and international football competitions as well as major sporting events.

- Capacity: 80,093 spectators.
- Address: Prolongación Javier Prado Avenue East, Block 77, Ate, Lima, Peru.



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TOURIST ATTRACTIONS

MAGIC WATER CIRCUIT

A nighttime show of dancing fountains, lights, and music at Parque de la Reserva. Ideal for enjoying with family or as a delegation.

BARRANCO

An artistic and bohemian district known for its murals, art galleries, live music, and charming cafés. Don't miss the famous Bridge of Sighs.

LARCO MUSEUM

A showcase of pre-Columbian art housed in a beautiful colonial mansion featuring gardens, a restaurant, and a gift shop. A true gem of Peruvian history.

MIRAFLORES BOARDWALK
