FUTSAL TECHNICAL REGULATIONS

IV FISU AMERICA GAMES – LIMA 2026

These Technical Regulations establish the sports rules governing the Futsal competition at the IV FISU AMERICA GAMES – LIMA 2026. They have been prepared by the Peruvian University Sports Federation (FEDUP) and approved by FISU AMERICA.

They are mandatory for all participants and shall be applied together with the General Regulations of the IV FISU AMERICA GAMES – LIMA 2026, as well as the regulations in force of FISU AMERICA and the FIFA Futsal Laws of the Game.

In the event of any discrepancy in the interpretation of these rules, the official English text of FIFA shall prevail.

Article 1. GENERAL INFORMATION

- **ORGANIZER** : FISU AMERICA and the Local Organizing Committee (LOC) - FEDUP.
- **VENUE** : IPD Polideportivo 1 – VIDENA
Villa El Salvador Sports Center - IPD
- **TECHNICAL MEETING** : July 25, 2026, in-person format. Time and venue to be confirmed.
- **COMPETITION** : from July 26 to August 1, 2026.
- **SCHEDULE** : shall be established in the Official Competition Program.

Article 2. COMPETITION AUTHORITIES

The Futsal competition shall be organized and supervised by:

- a) The FISU AMERICA Sports Technical Commission.
- b) The Local Organizing Committee (LOC) – Lima 2026.
- c) The Technical Coordinator for Futsal.



d) The Technical Delegate, referees and officials appointed by the LOC with FISU AMERICA approval.

Article 3. PARTICIPATION BY COUNTRY

a) Each country may register up to two (2) teams, distributed as follows:

- One (1) men's team.
- One (1) women's team.

b) Each team may register a minimum of twelve (12) and a maximum of fourteen (14) players.

c) Each team may register a minimum of one (1) and a maximum of four (4) technical officials.

d) The registration of additional personnel shall be governed exclusively by the provisions of the General Regulations of the Games.

Article 4. COMPETITION SYSTEM

The competition system shall be defined by the Local Organizing Committee in coordination with FISU AMERICA, according to the final number of registered teams, and may include:

- Group-stage system.
- Round Robin system.
- Final stages through knockout rounds.

All matches shall be played in accordance with the current FIFA Futsal Laws of the Game.

Article 5. STANDINGS AND SCORING TABLE

The standings table shall be prepared in accordance with the scoring system established by FIFA:

- Match won: three (3) points.



- Match drawn: one (1) point.
- Match lost: zero (0) points.
- Match lost by W.O.: zero (0) points, with a 3-0 score against.

The ranking shall be determined by the highest number of points obtained in the corresponding phase.

Article 6. TIE-BREAKING SYSTEM

6.1 Tie in points between two (2) teams

In the event of a points tie between two (2) teams, the ranking shall be determined by applying the following criteria in order:

- a) Result of the match played between the two teams.
- b) Goal difference (goals scored minus goals conceded) considering all matches in the phase.
- c) Greater number of goals scored considering all matches in the phase.
- d) Fair Play Table. e) Draw.

6.2 Tie in points among three (3) or more teams

When the tie involves three (3) or more teams, a partial table shall be prepared considering only the matches played among the tied teams, applying the following criteria:

- a) Goal difference among the teams involved.
- b) Greater number of goals scored among the teams involved.
- c) Goal difference considering all matches in the phase.
- d) Greater number of goals scored considering all matches in the phase.
- e) Fair Play Table.
- f) Draw.



Article 7. FAIR PLAY TABLE

- a) The Fair Play Table is intended to assess the disciplinary conduct of teams during the corresponding phase.
- b) For the purposes of this table, disciplinary points shall be assigned according to the following scale:

Disciplinary sanction	Score
Yellow card	10 points
Red card	20 points

- c) The total score shall be the accumulated sum of all cards received by the team during the evaluated phase.
- d) The team with the lowest disciplinary score shall be ranked higher.
- e) If the tie persists, a draw shall be held.

Article 8. MATCH DURATION

Matches shall be played in accordance with the FIFA Futsal Laws of the Game, including regulation time, intervals and tie-breaking procedures where applicable.

Article 9. DRAW AND GROUP FORMATION

- a) The official draw for the Futsal competition shall be held virtually on July 3, 2026, under the supervision of the Local Organizing Committee (LOC) and the FISU AMERICA Sports Technical Commission.
- b) The draw shall be conducted in accordance with FIFA principles and recommendations, ensuring sporting fairness, transparency and competitive balance.



c) For group formation and team seeding, the following shall be considered in order of priority:

- The host country and the champion country from the previous edition shall be placed in different groups through a directed draw, ensuring that both occupy the first position in their assigned group.
- Sporting results from previous editions of the FISU AMERICA Games.
- Additional technical criteria defined by the FISU AMERICA Technical Commission in coordination with the LOC.

d) If a country registers two (2) teams, they shall be placed in different groups, ensuring maximum transparency and competitive balance.

e) The draw result and preliminary schedule shall be made official through a Technical Bulletin.

Article 10. OFFICIAL UNIFORM

Teams must appear in official uniforms in accordance with current FIFA regulations and the General Regulations of the Games.

Each team must have two (2) sets of uniforms clearly differentiated by color (light and dark).

Article 11. OFFICIAL BALL

The Organizing Committee shall provide the official ball for all championship matches and competitions.

Article 12. OFFICIAL TECHNICAL MEETING

- a) The Official Technical Meeting for Futsal shall be held on July 25, 2026, in in-person format.
- b) Attendance is mandatory for all participating countries. Each delegation must be represented by:
 - The delegation and/or discipline delegate.
 - The team head coach.
- c) Countries must mandatorily present the official competition uniform during the Technical Meeting for color verification and regulatory compliance.
- d) The detailed agenda shall be communicated through a subsequent Technical Bulletin.

Article 13. TECHNICAL OFFICIALS

Referees and technical officials shall be appointed by the Local Organizing Committee, with FISU AMERICA approval.

Article 14. CONDUCT AND DISCIPLINE

The conduct of athletes and officials shall be governed by:

- FIFA disciplinary rules.
- The Disciplinary Regulations of the IV FISU AMERICA GAMES – LIMA 2026.



Article 15. UNFORESEEN CASES

Cases not covered in these Technical Regulations shall be resolved in accordance with Article 58 of the General Regulations of the IV FISU AMERICA GAMES LIMA 2026 and current FIFA regulations.
